State of Wyoming Report of Adoption

Parts I and II of this report should be filled out by the Petitioner or the Attorney for the Petitioner. Part III must be completed and certified by the Clerk of Court. All information stated in the Final Decree and Report of Adoption must be in agreement with the information that is on the original birth certificate. Each Report of Adoption must be accompanied by a certified copy of the Final Decree of Adoption. Certified copies must bear an original signature and raised or multicolored seal of the Clerk of Court's office. Interlocutory decrees are not acceptable.

If the child was born in Wyoming, mail the completed and certified Report of Adoption, a certified copy of the Final Decree, a filing fee of \$16.00, and a legible photocopy of a state issued identification card of the person signing the Report to Vital Records, Hathaway Building, Cheyenne WY 82002. Additional certified copies are \$8.00 each.

If the child was not born in Wyoming, the address of the Vital Records office for that state can be located by accessing www.cdc.gov/nchs and clicking on the link for where to write for birth records.
