Applicants should be holder of Hong Kong Identity Card;

Applicant should be a student enrolling in an award-bearing programme of duration of not less than one year offered by a recognized local post-secondary institution in Hong Kong;

## **Closing Date for Application**

The completed application form together with a proposal of the final year project / dissertation commencing in the academic year of 2014-15 in A4 size page (not more than 1,500 words) should be submitted to the Occupational Safety & Health Council, 19/F, China United Centre, 28 Marble Road, North Point, Hong Kong on or before 30 November 2014. All entries received will not be returned to the applicants.

#### **Selection Criteria**

- The Scholarship will be awarded to the applicants on grounds of potential implementation of a quality applied research project related to occupational safety and health.
- The areas of applied research can be in any subject area relating to occupational safety and hygiene, work ergonomics, accident prevention and loss control, construction safety, risk management, OSH for small and medium enterprises, safety and health products design, work injury and rehabilitation etc.
- The applied research projects can be final year project, honored or post-graduate degree dissertation which take at least one full semester to complete.
- A Selection Panel will take reference on the relevance, scientific merits, originality, and contributions to occupational safety and health in granting the scholarships.

Panel will not be required to divulge to any person why a particular applicant has not been selected. All information regarding the application, applicants and the selection process would be kept strictly confidential.

- 6. Shortlisted applicants may be invited to attend an interview; and attendance in person is required.
- Successful applicants will be notified through their project supervisor, subject leader, or programme leader.

# Publicity

- 1. Successful awardees may be required to provide the Council a summary report on the awarded research work in Chinese (between 2,000 to 5,000 words).
- The Council shall have the right to display, disseminate or release the award research work, i.e. the actual write-up and/or the product(s) as the output of the project in the form that the Council considers appropriate.
