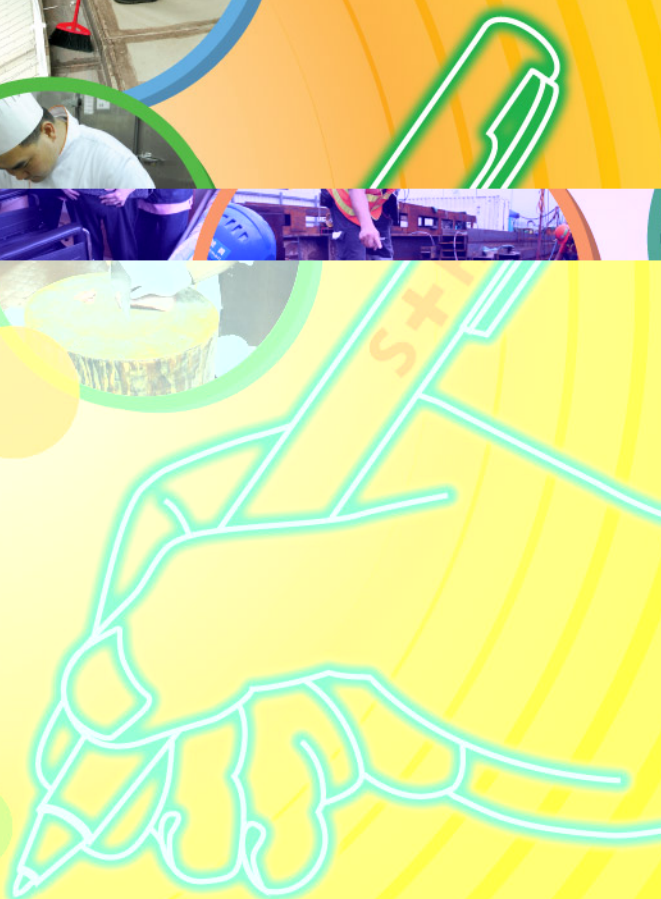

for the Academic Year 2014

Objective

The Occupational Safety & Health Student Research Scholarship is established for:

1. Promoting applied research related to occupational safety and health by students who study in post-secondary institutions in Hong Kong;
2. Rewarding students or groups of student who show potentials of implementing quality applied research in their study; and

Subsidizing the expenses incurred in the proposed study.

Students enrolling in post-secondary University / College / Institution of Vocational Education / Training Academy are invited to apply for this Scholarship.

Category

Applications will be in 3 categories in pursuit of :

- Postgraduate programmes; or
- Undergraduate programmes; or
- Sub-degree programmes.

Eligibility

Applicants should be holder of Hong Kong Identity Card;

Applicant should be a student enrolling in an award-bearing programme of duration of not less than one year offered by a recognized local post-secondary institution in Hong Kong;

Students can be studying postgraduate, graduate or sub-degree programme; and selection should be made via the project supervisor, subject leader, or programme leader with endorsement from the academic institution which offered the programme.

Number of the Scholarship

A total of 10 scholarships can be offered depending on the funding availability.

The value of each award is HK\$4,000.

Scholarship to be conferred to the applicant who has completed or is in the process of gaining of at least a satisfactory pass grade in the assessment component, programme under which the research work was conducted (maximum of three years of study for which award was granted).

The number of awardees is subject to the number of applications received, and is granted at the discretion of the Occupational Safety & Health Council.

Closing Date for Application

The completed application form together with a proposal of the final year project / dissertation commencing in the academic year of 2014-15 in A4 size page (not more than 1,500 words) should be submitted to the Occupational Safety & Health Council, 19/F, China United Centre, 28 Marble Road, North Point, Hong Kong on or before **30 November 2014**. All entries received will not be returned to the applicants.

Selection Criteria

1. The Scholarship will be awarded to the applicants on grounds of potential implementation of a quality applied research project related to occupational safety and health.
2. The areas of applied research can be in any subject area relating to occupational safety and hygiene, work ergonomics, accident prevention and loss control, construction safety, risk management, OSH for small and medium enterprises, safety and health products design, work injury and rehabilitation etc.
3. The applied research projects can be final year project, honored or post-graduate degree dissertation which take at least one full semester to complete.
4. A Selection Panel will take reference on the relevance, scientific merits, originality, and contributions to occupational safety and health in granting the scholarships.
5. Decision of Selection Panel would be final. The

Panel will not be required to divulge to any person why a particular applicant has not been selected. All information regarding the application, applicants and the selection process would be kept strictly confidential.

6. Shortlisted applicants may be invited to attend an interview; and attendance in person is required.
7. Successful applicants will be notified through their project supervisor, subject leader, or programme leader.

Publicity

1. Successful awardees may be required to provide the Council a summary report on the awarded research work in Chinese (between 2,000 to 5,000 words).
2. The Council shall have the right to display, disseminate or release the award research work, i.e. the actual write-up and/or the product(s) as the output of the project in the form that the Council considers appropriate.

1. A maximum of 10 subject to
2. The value of each award is HK\$4,000.
3. The scholarship is subject to the awarding of a satisfactory pass grade required by the assessment component, programme under which the research work was conducted (maximum of three years of study for which award was granted).
4. The number of awardees is subject to the number of applications received, and is granted at the discretion of the Occupational Safety & Health Council.
