- 11.3 All waste transported should be covered using appropriate materials. Refer to *Draft Guidelines For Transportation Of General Waste, Medical Waste, Sewage And Hazardous Waste, 2003.*
- 11.4 A successful applicant will be issued with two *M* s (green for non-hazardous and red for hazardous waste) to be affixed to the vehicle's driver's door and at the back. *M* represents Matlakala (waste)

#### SECTION E: PROVISIONS FOR HAZARDOUS WASTE CARRIERS ONLY

- 14.1 A submission of an adequate contingency plan to the department and shall include a detailed spill management plan, an accidental response procedures, appropriate clean up equipment and relevant emergency numbers in case of accidents.
- 14.2 All Vehicles should have a spill handling system stored in a separate compartment to the waste carrying compartment. Please refer to *Draft Guidelines for Transportation of General Waste, Medical Waste, Sewage and Hazardous Waste, 2003*

- 14.3 All transporters should have a *pollution liability cover* from a local insurance company.
- 14.3 A warning sign, legible from a distance of 20 m, shall be affixed and spread across the side of the carrier, reading, for example

"DANGER – IGNITABLE HAZARDOUS WASTE, NO OPEN FLAMES, SMOKING OR SPARKS"

eg. For Medical Waste Carriers "CLINICAL WASTE FOR INCINERATION ONLY"

14.4 Below the warning message and centred in the middle, a Waste Identification Card of A3 size should be affixed to the side of the Carrier.The CARD should appear in the format suggested overleaf depicting appropriate hazard sign/s and should acquire universally recognised colour codes.

ORANGE – explosive substances, RED –inflammable liquids RED and WHITE stripes –inflammable solids Half RED, half WHITE – spontaneously combustible BLUE – dangerous when wet WHITE – Poisonous and Infectious substances, etc
