We are writing to introduce S.A.G.E. (Scholarship for Advanced Guyanese Education). We are a group of former World Teach volunteers who taught in secondary schools throughout Guyana. We have established a scholarship fund for promising secondary school students who would like to attend the University of Guyana, but who do not have the financial means to do so. Student applicants must also be committed to contributing to Guyana's development once they have graduated from UG. The University of Guyana will make an initial short-list of applicants. From this short list, SAGE will make a final selection.

For selected applicants, our scholarship will fully fund a four-year degree programme at the University of Guyana, and a need based living stipend.

In order to apply for our scholarship, students must complete the University of Guyana application, as well as additional application materials. II. Good Standing with the School Student's Initials
SAGE recipients must be certified in good standing with the school, having no disciplinary
problems. If recipients fail to meet this criterion, they will go on a probationary period (outlined below).

III. Grade Point Average Requirement Student's Initials
SAGE recipients must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 for all credits with the school. Recip
ents must earn at least a 2.8 in every subject. If recipients fall below the required minimum, they must g
on a probationary period (outlined below).
IV. Submission of Transcripts Student's Initials
SAGE recipients must submit transcripts at the end of every school year. If a recipient fails to
do so, the recipient will receive a warning letter. If the transcript is not received by the beginning of the
semester, then the scholarship will be withheld and the SAGE recipient must reimburse SAGE for the tot
expenses SAGE paid over the course of your studies.
V. Contact with SAGE representative Student's Initials
SAGE recipients must maintain a minimum of monthly contact with their assigned SAGE representative an
respond promptly to all communications from SAGE. If a scholarship recipient fails to comply, the recipier
will go on a probationary period (outlined below). If continued contact is not kept, then the SAGE recipies
will lose the scholarship and be required to repay SAGE the full amount SAGE paid towards the student
academic studies.
VI. Yearly Review Student's Initials
At the end of each year, the SAGE Board will review the status of each recipient to determine if they med

VII. Probationary Period Student's Initials
In the event a recipient fails to stay in good standing with the school or meet the grade point average re
quirement, the recipient will be placed on a semester probationary period to fufill the requirements (e.g
return to good standing with the school or earn a 3.00 cumulative GPA). If the recipient fails to meet the
requirements, s/he will lose the scholarship. After a recipient goes on probation s/he must submit transcripts every semester.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

ABOUT SAGE

When I apply to SAGE, am I also applying to the University of Guyana with the same application?

No. You <u>MUST</u> apply to the University of Guyana separately. UG has its own application form that must be completed and submitted. <u>An applicant can only be selected as a SAGE scholar if they have been accepted for admission to the University of Guyana.</u> Please see the following page for more information about University of Guyana applications.

When will decisions be made?

After the application deadline, the University of Guyana short-lists applicants to ensure that they meet the requirements of the University. The applications are then sent to SAGE for review, and final selections are made. Typically, selections are made by late July.

How will I be notified?

If you submitted a contact card (part 9 of the application), you will hopefully have had successful communication with a SAGE representative by the time final selections are made. If selected, we will contact you through that established method and discuss any additional funds such as living expenses or transportation costs. You will also be mailed a copy of your acceptance letter that you will need to bring to University of Guyana for registration.

I submitted the contact information card to SAGE, but I haven't heard back!

If you do not hear from us within a few weeks of submitting your application, please contact us again, whether through e-mail or a letter. If you contact information changes, also please let us know so we can still contact you!

What happens if I get selected?

After selection, scholars must register at the University of Guyana (see details on next page). Please think about how, if selected, you would be able to get to Georgetown. In some cases, SAGE will reimburse expenses, but this will be decided on a case by case basis, and reimbursement cannot occur until after registration. If you will be moving into the dormitory, please pack appropriately.

What if I don't get selected?

If you are not selected as a SAGE scholar, you will receive a letter (either through e-mail or carrier mail) informing you of the status of your application. Even if you are not selected as a SAGE scholar, we still encourage anyone who wants to go to UG to do so! UG offers a student loan programme that can allow you to complete your studies and pay back tuition fees over time. Also, consider reapplying for a SAGE scholarship next year, assuming you meet all the entry requirements. The available funds and applicant pool changes every year, so take the opportunity to revise your essay, and make sure it really says what you want it to say!

How do I apply to University of Guyana?

What if I do not have internet access?

If you live in Regions 1,2,7,8, or 9 of Guyana, you can submit a paper application. These are available from:

- Regional Administration Office Regions 1, 7, 8, 9

Note that there is a small application fee for the University of Guyana application.

How do I register for UG?

In order to register you must go to UG's campus with passport photos and a copy of your SAGE acceptance letter. Your registration and tuition fees for your selected programme will be billed to SAGE directly.
